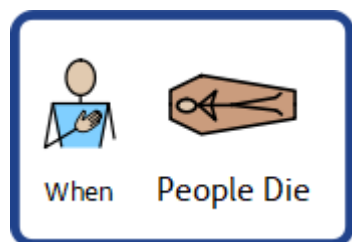

accompanying people with Intellectual disabilities as they face death and bereavement

Entirely taught online for 6 weeks, the course "**Don't Forget Me: accompanying people with Intellectual disabilities as they face death and bereavement**" will broaden your perspectives on religious, human and spiritual related issues. All you need is a good internet connection and your laptop.

“Talking about death and loss is never easy. Over time approaches to palliative care and bereavement have resulted in some very use-full resources for people to read and reflect upon. However, what if the person who is ill or bereft has an intellectual disability or a differing form of

communication? Why is there so much to support very typical forms of communication but so little for people who need a more creative approach as they face death? This Course, ‘Don't Forget Me’ will grapple with such important dilemmas. Participants will also learn how to engage in the creative, practical and spiritual accompaniment, of people with intellectual disabilities, as they travel through experiences of palliative care, death and bereavement”
